**Invitation for Expression of Interest (EOI)**  
**For**  
**Implementing HIV/AIDS Targeted Intervention service for People Living with HIV/AIDS (PLHA) in Nepal**

The National Association of PLHIV in Nepal (NAP+N) invites Expressions of Interest (EOI) by eligible PLHIV led CBO/NGO interested to run Community Care Center (CCC) for PLHIV in selected 16 districts – Dhanusah, Makawanpur, Sindhupalchok, Kavre, Bhanktapur, Nuwakot Dhading, Nawaparasi, Tahanu, Syangja, Baglung, Bardiya, Dadeldhura, Baitadi, Dailekha and Bajura as per contract with government of Nepal.

The selected organization is expected to run Community Care Center near the ART site of their respective district to support the newly enrolled ART clients to increase ART adherence among PLHIV and to facilitate to enroll for ART for needy one. The activities should be undertaken in close consultation with Program Management Unit (PMU) of National Association of PLHIV in Nepal.

The Interested organization should have the following competencies:

- a) Must be a local CBO/NGO
- b) Must be lead and managed by local PLHIV community
- c) Experienced and knowledge of the situation of the HIV and AIDS epidemic in Nepal and related programmes;
- d) Strong communication and reporting skills
- e) Sound programmatic and financial record
- f) If already running care homes for PLHIV, would be value added.

The NAP+N invite interested PLHIV lead CBO/NGO to express their interest in providing the above mentioned services. Interested organizations must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services i.e. organization profile, certificate of registration, tax clearance certificate /renewal (if apply), description of experiences in the similar assignment, annual financial audit of last 2 years (if apply) and availability of appropriate skills among staffs and facilities in their offices.

The selection will be undertaken on the basis of quality and good will of respective organization in their local level.
